**This is a formal notice of a 60-day comment period for *proposed* Link5G sites in your district. It is a solicitation of feedback on potential sites that have otherwise been identified as viable. Please provide feedback by March 12<sup>th</sup>. Feedback will be accepted via e-mail from your offices or the general public at [Link5GFeedback@oti.nyc.gov](mailto:Link5GFeedback@oti.nyc.gov).**

The Office of Technology and Innovation (OTI) is reaching out to inform you that we have identified proposed sites of Link5G kiosks in your district. As you may already be aware, Link5G is the second generation of the LinkNYC kiosk. It will provide all the same services you've come to expect from the original LinkNYC design, including free high-speed Wi-Fi, free nationwide calling, free charging ports for mobile devices, and 911 and 311 access. The added benefit of Link5G is that its new design will also enable the deployment of 4G and 5G infrastructure to enhance cellular service in your area.
